## Things you need to know:

<b>1. In order for me to sell your merchandise, I would have to have physical custody of it. So, you would have to set up an appointment to bring it over here. Please check with me before you bring anything over to make sure we have room to display it.</b>
<b>2. I charge 10% of the actual selling price for <u>each item</u>. If you take the items back before I sell them, there is no charge. This charge includes, my taking a picture of each of your items, a free listing on Bisman Online, and a listing on my website.</b>
<b>3. Sales Tax will be charged on top of the actual selling price you charge for your item. Starting April 1, 2025 the Sales Tax Rate is 8% (North Dakota 5%, Burleigh County 1% and Bismarck 2%).</b>
<b>4. Most Sales are cash but if someone uses PayPal or Venmo those charges will be subtracted from the amount each item sells for. PayPal is \$0.30 + 2.9% for a \$1.00 item, \$0.49 + 2.99% for a \$100.00 item and \$0.49 + 3.49% for a \$1000.00 item. Venmo is \$1.00 to \$4.99 would be a \$0.49 charge, \$5.00 to \$24.99 would be a \$0.99 charge, \$25.00 to \$74.99 would be \$1.99 charge, \$75.00 to \$200.00 would be a \$2.49 charge, \$200.01 to \$1000.00 would be 1.80%. It did say that credit card charges would be charged at a rate of 3%. They tell me these charges cannot be passed on to the customer so it would come out of the money you would normally charge for your items so allow for that in your price. Venmo is owned by PayPal and that is why it is in my store. Since I have no control over PayPal and Venmo charges I cannot say what the exact charges will be, but it will be reflected in the receipts that go with any money you receive for your sales. And my experience is that most people will probably pay cash.</b>
<b>5. There are some items that Bisman Online charges to list on their site. So, anything they charge for to list I will not list on Bisman. One item I know they charge to list is craft items. I think they charge \$19.99 a month for those ads. Craft items are listed on my website included in the 10% listing fee.</b>
<b>6. All customers must put the items they want to buy into the shopping cart on my website because they have to pay sales tax and/or shipping if they have the item shipped to them. Not all items can be shipped, only the small items because shipping costs are really high right now.</b>
<b>7. By North Dakota law I can do 4 public garage sales per year. In 2025 I plan to do them in March, May, July and September. All private garage sales which I can do all throughout the year as well as curbside pickup have to be by appointment per a Bismarck Law passed in August of 2024.</b>
<b>8. I also have limited space and time to stock and list items. So please check with me first before you fill this form out especially if you have large items.</b>
<b>9. Also, you will not get rich selling your new or used stuff. Sometimes if a customer offers a lesser price for something that has been here a long time or something that is big and in my way, I generally take the offer on my own stuff. That is why I ask you for the price you want and the lowest you will take. I would say that 70% of all sales, no one asks for a lower price but at least 30% do ask for a lower price.</b>
<b>10. I cannot guarantee that people will buy any of your items. To be honest everything I have posted for sale through the years has sold, but not always for the price I wanted or within the first month. Some things have not sold for two years or more and then all of the sudden someone does come along and buy it. So don't get your hopes up that everything will sell immediately because some stuff does and some does not.</b>
